



2017 Community Teacher of the Year Nomination Instructions and Form

The Community Teacher of the Year Award celebrates excellence in a community family medicine preceptor for the academic teaching year. Ontario's family medicine residents, medical school students and any other health-care learners may submit nominations.

Nomination is open to candidates who are OCFP members and community-based physicians who demonstrate the following:

- Excellence in Teaching
- Broad scope of teaching at the community level
- Strong mentorship skills
- Positive impact on students and learning environment
- Demonstrates and promotes the *Four Principles of Family Medicine* as defined by the Canadian College of Family Physicians:
 - The family physician is a skilled clinician
 - Family medicine is a community-based discipline
 - The family physician is a resource to a defined practice population
 - The patient-physician relationship is central to the role of the family physician

The Award will be presented at the OCFP's Awards Ceremony in November in Toronto.

Deadline for nominations: March 31, 2017

Instructions

Please include the following materials in the Community Teacher of the Year nomination package:

- The completed nomination form (see last page)
- A nomination letter that describes the nominee and provides evidence and examples of excellence in community family medicine preceptorship/teaching. The letter should address the following criteria:
 - Describe and give examples of the nominee's quality of instruction
 - Describe the scope of teaching (e.g. palliative, hospital in-patient, long-term care, emergency, obstetrics, etc.)
 - Provide specific examples of teaching, leadership and mentorship excellence
 - Describe role as a mentor beyond clinical teaching skills (e.g. work/life balance, community involvement, health advocate)
 - Any other relevant examples of teaching excellence
- Please type the nomination package to ensure it is clear and legible and keep the letter to two pages. Feel free to use bullets where appropriate
- At least one letter of support (to a maximum of five letters)
 - Letters from other family medicine residents, medical school students, or other medical learners that detail the nominees impact on their learning experience are strongly recommended.
