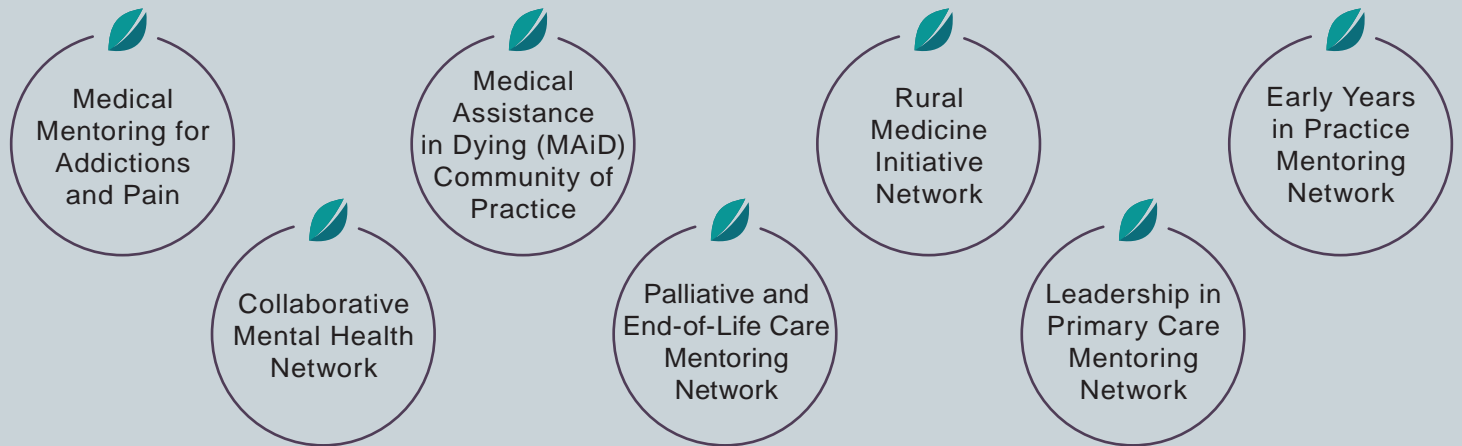
Collaborative Mentoring Networks

- Earn Mainpro+ credits

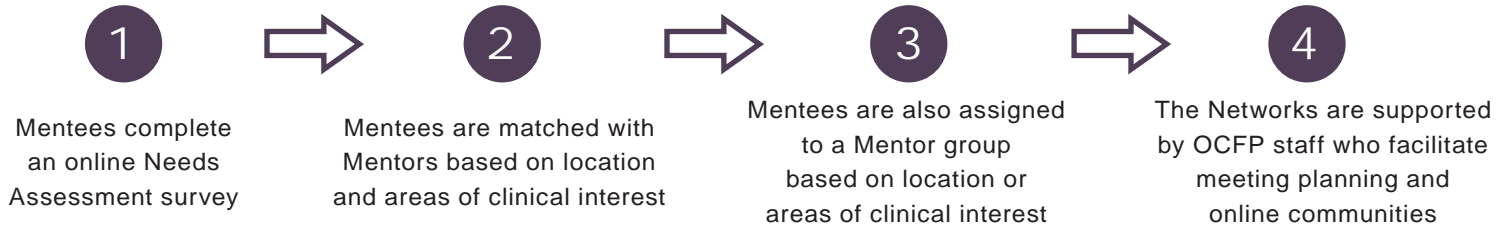

Continuing Professional Development

Mentors provide timely responses to Mentees' needs for advice using various channels, including telephone calls and email.

Mentoring Groups
